Alice Springs Reptile Centre houses the largest reptile display in the Northern Territory. They have an extensive range of reptiles including the Perentie Goanna, Frill Neck Lizards, Thorny Devils, Snakes of all types - Pythons and some of the world's most venomous snakes such as Inland Taipans, Brown Snakes, Death Adders and Mulga (King Brown) Snakes, and a saltwater crocodile!

The fossil cave houses cast fossils that trace the rise of the reptilian fauna from the sea over 200 million years ago to the present.
